Fall conclave is coming up October 5.

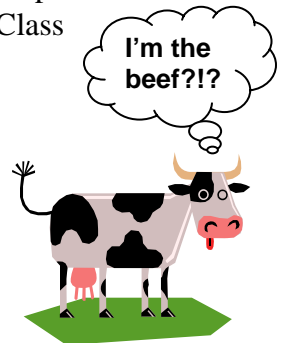

## New Ring

As many of you know, we have put a new ring in at McClintock. Just recently, we added a very nice feature to that ring that many of our fire builders will appreciate, a fire ring. The ring is between 1' and 1 1/2' high, and is in the shape of a triangle. On each one of the points is a "W" symbolizing Wimachtendienk, Wingolauchsik, and Witahemui. There is also a number 288 in the ring. It faces north, and looks really nice.



Seal your brotherhood in The Order of the Arrow by completing your brotherhood at Fall Fellowship. It is really easy to do. All you have to do is show up at Fall Fellowship having been an ordeal member for 10 months, and go to the ordeal member's meeting. We would encourage you to write your letter ahead of time. If you have any desire to learn more about our order, strengthen the ties of brotherhood, or aspire to get a new sash, seal your membership and get your brotherhood. Go to Fall fellowship, go to the ordeal member's meeting, go on the brotherhood hike, and get ready to learn more about our honored order who's membership you will affirm.
